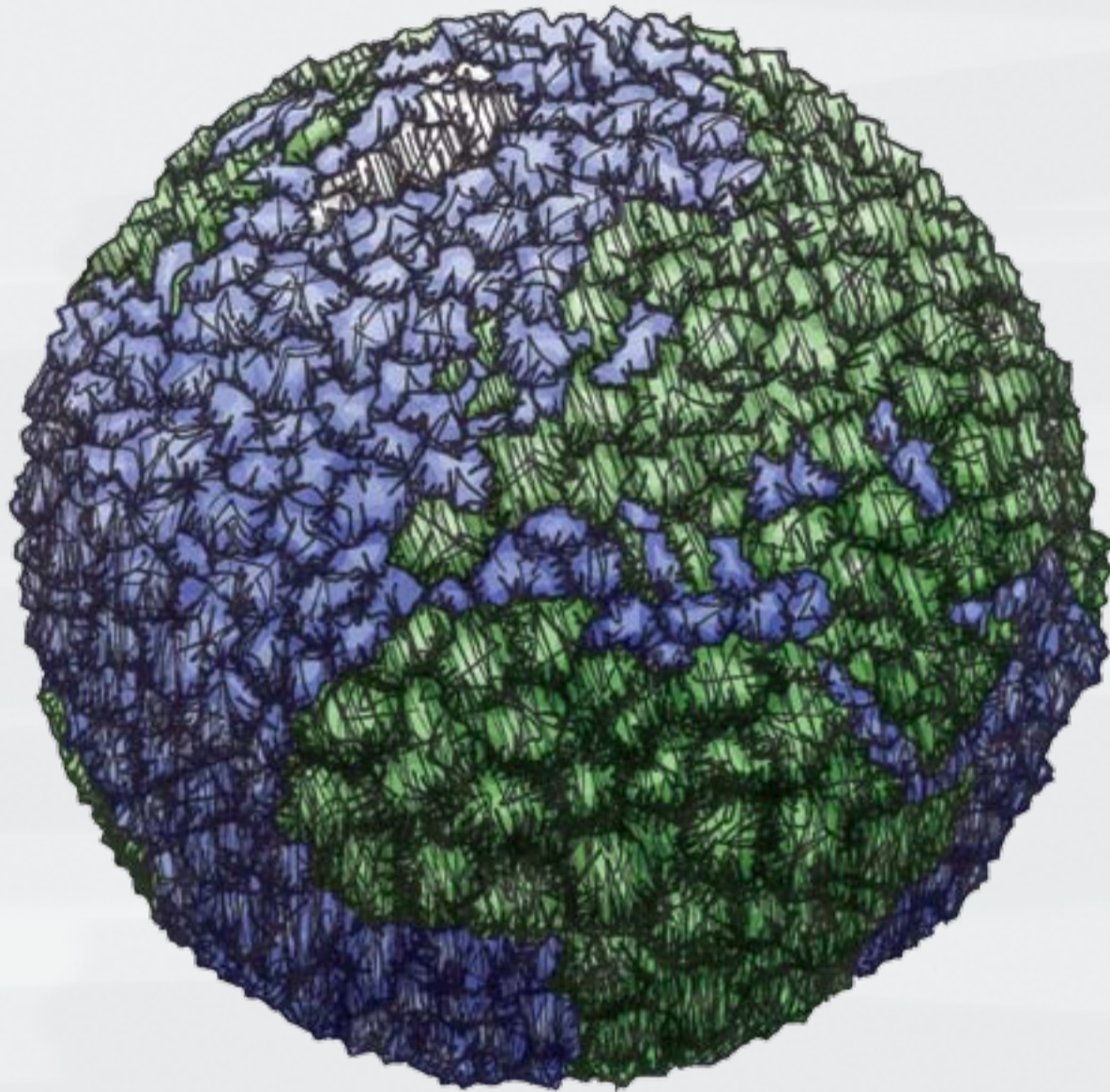


Go WILD for World Environment Day
